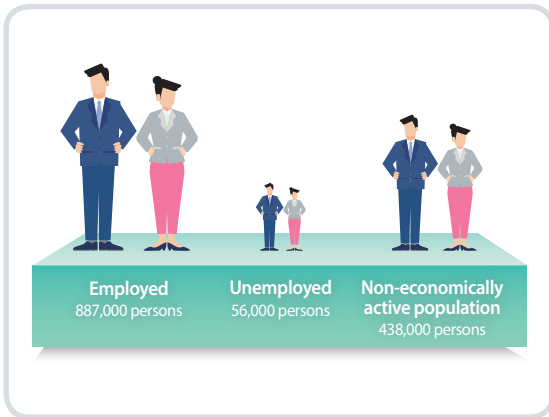


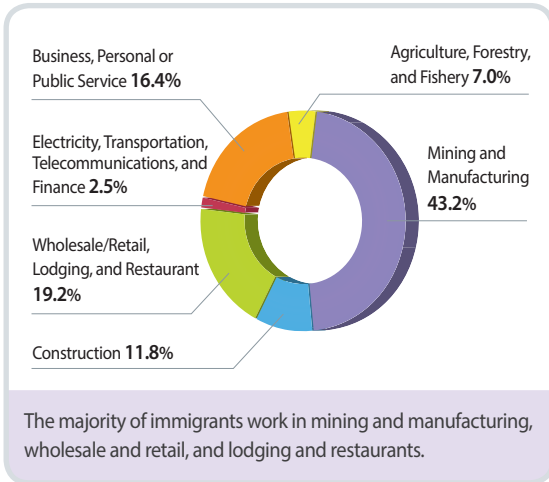

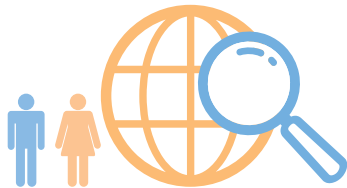

## What is the Survey on Immigrants' Living Conditions and Labour Force?

The survey on Immigrants' Living Conditions and Labour Force is jointly conducted by the Ministry of Justice and Statistics Korea to assess the living conditions, employment status and unemployment status of foreigners and naturalized Koreans living in Korea.

## How and what does the survey examine?

A staff interviewer of Statistics Korea will visit your home, workplace or school for the survey.

The survey will examine matters related to your education, residence and living environment, etc. during the reference period (May 15 - 21, 2022).

## Why should I participate in the survey?

Statistics Korea has selected you as one of samples based on a sampling theory to make accurate statistics.

## Do I have to participate in the survey?

As one of the selected samples, you represent about 2 million immigrants in Korea. If you do not take part in the survey, the results of the survey will become inaccurate and the immigration policy of the government based on this survey may be ineffective. So, we ask for your cooperation in participating in this survey.

## How can I participate in the survey?

You may participate in the survey through ① a **survey interview** or ② a **self-administered questionnaire**.

- ① Survey interview: answer interviewer's questions during a survey interview
- ② Self-administered questionnaire: fill in the questionnaire on your own which will be collected later by a staff interviewer of Statistics Korea

If you want to self-administer the survey questionnaire, you can get a copy from a staff interviewer of Statistics Korea during his/her visit or by calling the contact number on a Statistical Survey Collection Notice for absentee visits.

## Could there be any disadvantages as a result of my responses?

Your response is solely used for statistical purposes under Article 33 (Protection of Secrets) and Article 34 (Duty of Statistics staff, etc.) of the Statistical Act. Thus, there will be no disadvantage for you from your response.

Please note, even if your status of residence, address, and employment do not match previously recorded information, your response will only be used for statistical purposes and not for any other purpose.

## What is Statistics Korea?

Statistics Korea is a central government agency that compiles key statistics such as population, prices, and employment status needed for the government of the Republic of Korea to make its policies.
