Monk Seong Gak receives a plaque of appreciation from Korea Correctional Service

In recognition of his contributions in prison reform and the opening of Geochang Detention Center –

On November 24, 2023, Korea Correctional Service (Commissioner Shin Yong Hae) under the Ministry of Justice awarded Monk Seong Gak (the chief monk of Mangunsa Temple in Namhae, Gyeongsangnam-do) with a plaque of appreciation in recognition of his major contributions in prison reform and the opening of the Geochang Detention Center.

Monk Seong Gak, who is the only holder of Busan's intangible cultural heritage in *seonhwa* (Zen painting; brushstrokes of lines), served as a member of the corrections committee for the past 32 years.
